Some Useful Information...

Sick Calls / Visitations

Anyone seriously ill, preparing for surgery or to be hospitalized should contact Fr. Peter, Archdeacon David, or the Cathedral Office as soon as possible to receive the Sacraments of the Church. Persons unable to come to the Divine Liturgy regularly and wish to receive a visit from the priest and Holy Communion at home should telephone the Cathedral Office.

Special Prayers & Blessings

To schedule a Memorial (Trisagion) Service, The Churcing of Mother & Child, Removal of Marriage Crowns, etc, please telephone the Cathedral Office by Wednesday before the scheduled prayer/blessing to be included in the Weekly Bulletin.

Baptisms and Weddings

Parents wishing to baptize their children will need to schedule an appointment with the priest to make the necessary arrangements. It is the practice of the Orthodox Church that at least one of the Godparents must be an Orthodox Christian in good standing.

Couples planning to enter into the Sacrament of Marriage must meet with the priest not less than six (6) months in advance of their intended wedding date.

Offering Holy Bread and Memorial Wheat (Aamaah)

If you would like to offer Holy Bread for the Divine Liturgy, please speak to Fr. Peter, contact the Cathedral Office (305) 444-6541, or e-mail at: stgeorgecoralgables@gmail.com. Holy Bread is traditionally offered for the health of, or in memory of a loved one.

Those who wish to offer Wheat (Aamaah) for 9 Day, 40 Day and 1 Year Memorial Service for their loved one, please contact Fr. Peter at least 1 week in advance. The cost \$150.00 for a tray of Wheat.
